Pisces is very important in all of these cases. So astrology gives you the clue as to whether a disease is chemical or mechanical.

## URANUS AND SPASM

What orthodox medicine can consider psychological may be physical. I met a man on the plane coming to New York. had been in a mental asylum, supposedly insane. He told me he had spent \$20,000 in vain. I told him what was wrong; he had Uranus in Libra opposition the Moon. I told him he had a condition that is known in medicine. He had spasms in the blood vessels of the kidney. His kidney functions didn't perform properly and those poisons can be deposited in the brain and they can produce anything in the body and in his case they rendered him insane. Now there was nothing wrong with his mind; it was his body. The interesting thing was, I asked him, "Didn't you consult Dr. Cannon in London, Dr. Cannon, the occult doctor?" He said, "Yes, he hypnotized his subject." And here's a very curious thing. His hypnotic subject said, concerning this man, that there was a peculiar tightness over the lower back. Now, that's getting very near it. Anyhow there are certain homeopathic remedies. I had another case of the same thing just the other day -- a man, and incidently he had studied medicine for some time. He had had injections of alcohol, he had had all kinds of physical therapies, and now they wanted to bore a hole in his head. They wanted to do a pre-frontal lobotomy or some thing. I just laughed and said, "My good man, what a pity you have been so long in coming here." In three weeks that man was free from that dreadful pain, and he had this very thing--spasm. The same treatment that helped this man also helped the other one. So you see, the public pays an awful price for its ignorance. It pays a terrible price for its unawareness. You can't blame the doctors if they want to be very orthodox, and they are afraid to face a little condemnation.

## ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS IN DISEASE

Another influence is environmental factors. You have no idea the tremendous difficulties the average doctor faces. My only criticism is that he isn't progressive enough to use new methods. A lady came to me once about her boy who was in the hospital with a very bad heart and the doctors were doubtful of his living. I looked at his chart. To this day I have never seen the boy. I saw a tenanted Scorpio in the fourth house. Scorpio, as you know, is sewage and Saturn was there and, I think, afflicting the Sun. So I asked her, "Do you live out of town?" She said, "Yes, I live in the country." I said,
